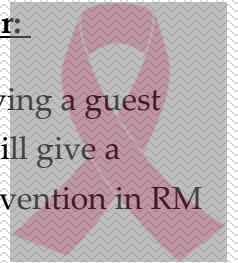
Friday Raffle:
