5.1 Director's Report	There were a lot of accomplishments this school year. We had a successful charter petition renewal from Escuela Popular CTC program. In addition, Escuela Popular was involved with a self-study this year. We have conducted a WASC self-study and received the WASC accreditation for both the AFLC and CTC High Schools for 6 years.	
	There are many things to look forward in the new school year. The Bilingual Family Learning Center will be in one site. We will have an enhanced instructional coach	
	support for all teachers. We have done work concerning zoning for the new school year that includes the welcoming center, the elementary and middle school, the high school youth and adults, the childcare center and the staff lounge. The Future Teacher Pathway Program includes students and staff that have not completed their Bachelor's	
	Degree or Credentialing Program to take online classes. We have 42 staff and alumini students that are currently registered for this program. We had a first cohort session on June 15 <sup>th</sup> .	
	The enrollment for Escuela Popular and across the area have been reducing. The three year analysis shows dips on certain months and looking for ways to intervene to keep	4:41 PM
	the ADA in a steady level. The ADA targets for the AFLC program is 376 and CTC program is 334 in the AM and 334 in the PM. We informed the staff that we will maintain level of benefits at the same levels and maintain the retirement contribution at the same level. 	The credit completion rate for the High School CTC program is 73%. The rate for the High School AFLC program is 79%. We are focusing more on instructional mentoring the	
	next school year. We had students complete a district level assessment to measure	
	their levels in reading and math. We use the NWEA as the program for assessing the	5:10 PM
	students. The growth targets for 3 <sup>rd</sup> to 8 <sup>th</sup> grade is 48%; the growth target for the High	3.101101
	School AFLC is 47%; the growth target for the High School CTC is 43%. The average score	
	increase for the High School AFLC between the pre and post was 85 points. The average	
	score increase for the High School CTC between the pre and post was 45 points. The 3 <sup>rd</sup>	
	to 8 <sup>th</sup> grade students had an improvement on their Lexile Score by 69% from last year.	
	The High School AFLC program improved by 49%; the High School CTC prgroam	
	improved by 52%. The reading portion for the NWEA MAP Pre- and Post- RiT scores	
	average for the Dual Langauge is 189 points in the fall and 195 points in the spring; for the High School AFLC program, the scores is 185 points in the fall and 187 points in the	
	spring; for the High School CTC program, the scores is 191 points in the fall and 194	
	points in the spring.
